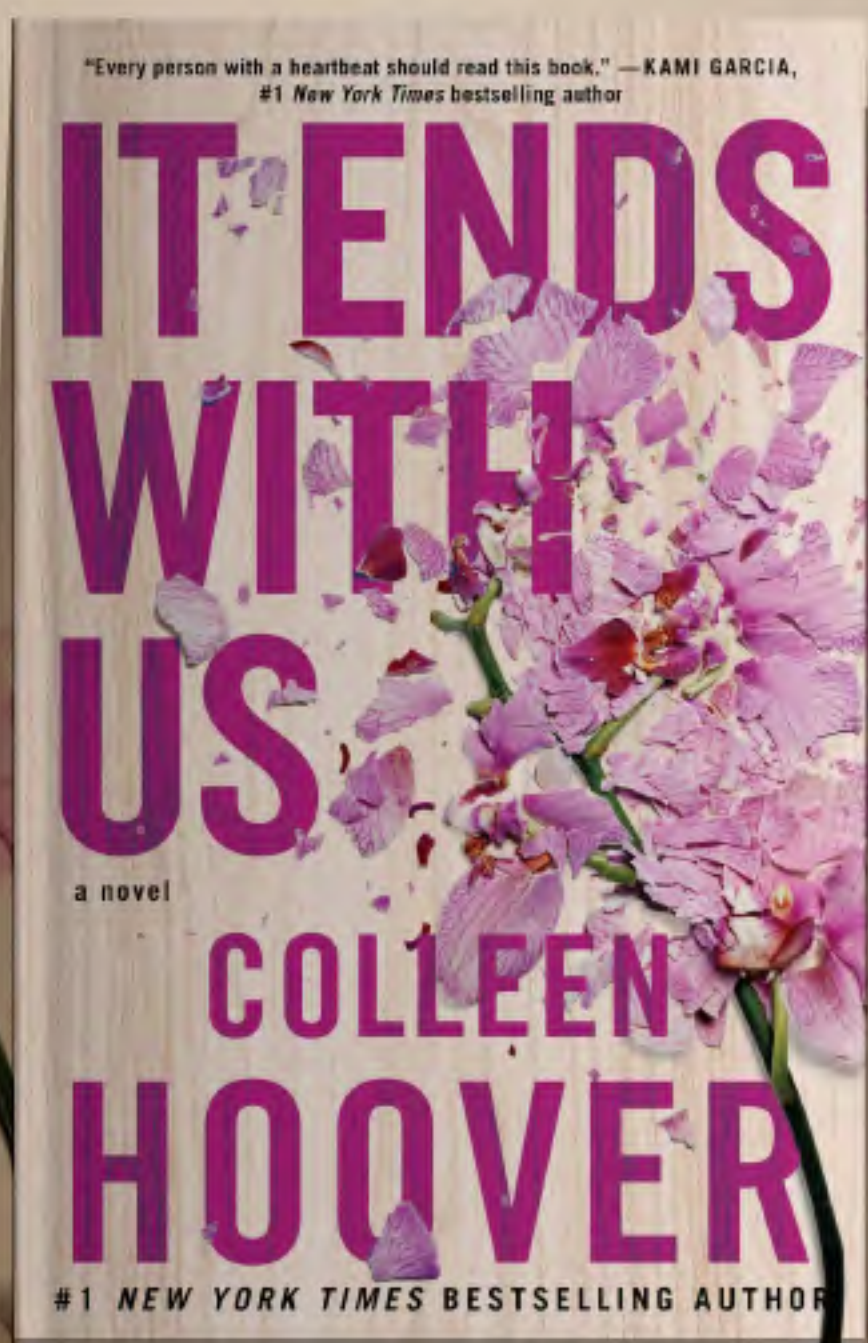
The Light Between Oceans
